ATTENDANCE

PHD follows a similar calendar to the Olathe School District school calendar for Thanksgiving, winter, and spring break. **When the Olathe Schools are closed for inclement weather, so is PowerHouse Dance.** Look at PHD's calendar for other breaks given. If you have any questions concerning the cancellation of classes please contact the studio. **Make-up classes are not given due to cancellation by inclement weather.** If you are late picking up your dancer after their class is over, then you will have to pay the instructor the waiting on your dancer. For every 5 minutes you are late, then a \$5.00 fee will need to be given to the instructor waiting on your dancer to be picked up. If this fee is not paid for at the time you are late picking up your dancer, then you will receive an invoice. This is only for the last class given for the day.

MAKE-UP CLASSES

Make-up classes are allowed for student illness and emergencies only. These classes must be made up within the trimester of absence, and may not be accumulated. These policies are in effect to ensure the integrity of the classes and promote regular attendance. *PHD reserves the right to cancel a class if less than four students show up or if the instructor is unable to attend. In this case, an appropriate make-up class will be designated. If you miss a class in ballet then a ballet class would need to be made-up.*

CLASS INFORMATION

Class sizes will be limited to a reasonable number. A minimum of 5 students in a class is required. If a class does not make the minimum requirement, then it will be cancelled and a refund will be sent to you in the mail.

PHD runs by a strict level of technique. A student will be placed in a class by her/his level of ability, not necessarily age. PHD will place dancers at their personal level.

CLASSROOM ATTIRE

Tiny Two's, Rhythm & Movement, Creative Dance, and Combination Classes: *Girls* – Black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes with elastic instead of ribbons, and hair pulled back. Any color ballet skirt can be worn. *Boys* – Black biker shorts, white t-shirt, black ballet shoes, and black tap shoes.

Ballet Classes: *Levels I/III/Teen*– Black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, and hair pulled back in a bun with bobby pins. No exceptions! *Levels III/IV* – Any solid color leotard, pink/black tights, ballet skirts (optional), pink ballet shoes, and hair pulled back into a bun with bobby pins. No exceptions!

Modern, Jazz, Hip Hop, Leap & Turn Classes: *Level I-IV* – Any solid color leotard, tights, jazz pants, jazz shoes, and hair pulled back. No loose t-shirts, shorts, or midriiffs! Hip Hop classes may wear clean tennis shoes or go barefoot. All Modern classes go barefoot.

Tap Classes: Same as Jazz Classes. Black flat tap shoes.

RECITAL

Each class, with the exception of Leap & Turn Classes, will perform one routine in the recital. Each separate class requires a different costume. There are two recital payments. Both payments are due in October. This payment is for your dancer's recital costume(s) and reserves your dancers spot in the show and sets aside two tickets for your family to attend one of the shows. Ticket sales begin in April. **All recital payments are non-refundable.**

ENROLLMENT

There is an annual enrollment fee of \$25.00 per student. An enrollment form, enrollment agreement form, and recital agreement form must be signed prior to first class. If a student is adding or discontinuing a class, then Erica Frans and Carrie Schmidt must be notified by a written letter. PHD charges by the trimester (every three months). Tuition must be paid at time of enrollment to ensure a place in the class. Payments can either be mailed or paid in person. If payment is mailed, then it must be received before the 10th of the month or a \$20.00 fee will be assessed. There will be a \$25.00 fee on all returned checks. Fees are not pro-rated. We give those families with two or more children enrolled a discount on their total tuition. **Tuition is non-refundable.**

COMPANY

Auditions for the 2007-2008 PHD Company will be held August 4th, 2007. There will be different audition times for different ages. Company will compete at 4-5 competitions annually and will perform for audiences locally. Company is required to take fall and summer classes. Applications are at the studio.
